




## Harvester Kids Weekly Activities

<b>March 29</b> Memorize the scripture verse for today. God is our refuge and strength, a tested help in times of trouble. <sup>2</sup> And so we need not fear... <b>Psalm 46:1-2a (TLB)</b>	<b>March 30</b> Make a poster with the scripture verse. Make <b>bubble letters</b> to make the poster. Put it up in a place where you can be reminded of how God is with us. Take a picture and share with a friend.	<b>March 31</b> Take a walk outside and talk about the power of God that you see. Talk about how God's power is displayed in nature: rain, thunder, lightning, plants, flowers, rocks, etc.	<b>April 1</b> Fold a paper into four sections. Draw a picture in each section showing God's power in nature.  Label each picture telling how God's power is shown in each picture.	<b>April 2</b> Write a letter to one of your neighbors telling them the story of Lazarus. Make sure that you add the scripture verse. Put it in a neighbor's mailbox. Remember to add that God Loves Them.	<b>April 3</b> The birds are returning to our neighborhoods. Help to feed them by getting an empty toilet paper roll and run a string through it. Tie the string ends together. Smear peanut butter around the outside of the roll. Roll it through bird seeds. Hang it outside for the birds.	<b>April 4</b>  This stain glass art can be made on a window or glass door to remind people that God is with them. Use painter's tape to make your shapes making sure that you have a cross in the middle. Mix acrylic paint with dish soap for easy cleanup. You can sponge in the colors or use a brush. When you are all done, take a picture and post it on Harvester This!
