Make sure that you add the scripture verse. Put it in a neighbor's mailbox. Remember to add that God Loves Them.</p>	<p>April 3</p> <p>The birds are returning to our neighborhoods. Help to feed them by getting an empty toilet paper roll and run a string through it. Tie the string ends together. Smear peanut butter around the outside of the roll. Roll it through bird seeds. Hang it outside for the birds.</p>	<p>April 4</p>  <p>This stain glass art can be made on a window or glass door to remind people that God is with them. Use painter's tape to make your shapes making sure that you have a cross in the middle. Mix acrylic paint with dish soap for easy cleanup. You can sponge in the colors or use a brush. When you are all done, take a picture and post it on Harvester This!</p>
