Share it with your family.</p>	<p>April 14 Egg Shakers Use some plastic eggs and open them up. Fill the bottom of the egg with rice or beans. Glue the top to the bottom of the egg together. Make a variety of shakers to make different sounds.</p>	<p>April 15 Music Video This week you had two song with the lesson. Practice singing along with the video and use the shakers that you made as you sing. Ask your parents to videotape you as you sing along. Post it on Harvest This so that you can encourage your church family as we all stay home.</p>	<p>April 16 Poster Making</p>  <p>Place crayon stubs without wrappers on cardboard and place on a foil-covered pan. Bake at 250 for 10 mins or until it melts. Use the side of a craft stick to smooth the wax on the foil. Draw designs in the wax once the wax is starting to cool.</p>	<p>April 17 Story Writing Have a family story-writing competition. Help younger ones who may be unable to write but can still make up their own story – they could tell their story with pictures, or you can write it for them while they tell it. Or for a keepsake, you could video them telling you the tale. Sharing this is always advisable.</p>	<p>April 18 Letter Writing Think of someone who may need encouraging. It could be your teacher, grandparents, church family, etc. Write a letter or email and let them know what you have learned about Jesus. Let them know that the Lord has Risen, and we have our hope in him.</p>
