




## Harvester Kids Weekly Activities

<p><b>April 19</b>  <b>God's Word</b>            Memorize the scripture verse for today. Use yarn to hang it up on your front door.</p>	<p><b>April 22</b>  <b>Earth Day Craft</b></p>  <p>Flatten out a coffee filter on a plate. Scribble the filter with blue and green washable markers. Squirt 2 or 3 times with water in the center and watch the water wick the colors over the filter (4 or 5 minutes). Young Let dry.
