



<p>April 26 Bible Verse Memorize this week's bible verse: Do not be conformed to this world, but continuously be transformed by the renewing of your minds so that you may be able to determine what God's will is, what is proper, pleasing, and perfect. Roman 12:2</p>	<p>April 27 Bird Watching Sit in front of your house or by a window and see how many different types of birds are around. Draw a picture of the birds that you see. Research the birds that you see by its features. Add information to the picture to remind you of God's creation.</p>	<p>April 28 Bird Feeder</p>  <p>Use any empty, cleaned, plastic container to make a feeder. Cut a hole 2/3 of the way down as the opening for the birds. Make a small hole below the first hole and place a stick for the birds to sit on. Decorate the outside. Tie a string around to top of the container, add glue and screw the top over the string. Hang it outside with bird seeds in it.</p>	<p>April 29 Star gaze Make a telescope from a paper towel or a bathroom tissue cardboard roll. Design the roll with stars and planets. On a clear night, just sit outside on your front porch and look up at the beautiful constellations.</p>	<p>April 30 Kite Flying</p>  <p>Make a simple kite with paper, sticks, tape and string. Decorate your kite with markers or crayons. Follow the above instructions. Try flying your kite on a windy day.</p>	<p>May 1 May Day On this first day of May, go and look to see how many different flowers have come up in your neighborhood. Make pictures of the different flowers and place them on your front door to share with those who pass by.</p>	<p>May 2 Pin Wheel</p>  <p>Make a pin wheel with paper, a pin, and a pencil. Start with a square piece of paper and color one side of the paper. Follow the above instructions. Once you have pinned together the paper, place the pin into the pencil eraser. The pin should not go all the way through the eraser.</p>
