

Palm Sunday – Jesus Changes Everything

Bible Passage: Mark 11:1-11, 14:12-26

Memory Verse: For great is your love, reaching to the heavens; your faithfulness reaches to the skies.

Psalm 57:10

During this week we will keep our focus on Christ. Christ loved us so much that he suffered so that we could have life. Keep this in mind, as you read/listen to this week's story.

Read the passage to the children

- Read the two different passages in the book of Mark. Make sure that the children can summarize what is happening in the story.
- For preschool children, familiarize yourself with the story, and just tell the story to the children.
- Stop at certain intervals to ask questions about what you have just read or said.
- Explain what words mean, especially terms that are not common today.
