

The Holy Spirit Brings Change

Bible Passage: Matt 28:16-20; Acts 2:1-47

Memory Verse: Do not be conformed to this world, but continuously be transformed by the renewing of your minds so that you may be able to determine what God's will is—what is proper, pleasing, and perfect.
Romans 12:2

Jesus resurrection did not mean that all was lost. He promised to send a comforter. Today's lesson will help us witness the power that Jesus promised us.

Read the passage to the children

- The passages are long so make sure that the kids can summarize sections of the story as they are reading with you.
- For preschool children, familiarize yourself with the story, and just tell the story to the children.
- Stop at certain intervals to ask questions about what you have just read or said.
- Explain what words mean, especially terms that are not common today.

Discussion

- What are some of the main points of Peter's sermon?
- If you decided to share this message to people you know, how do you think that they would respond?
- What does this message mean to you?
