

# Courage

**Bible Passage:** Daniel 3:1-30

**Memory Verse:** Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;  
in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

Proverbs 3:5-6

## Read the passage to the children

- The passages are long so make sure that the kids can summarize sections of the story as they are reading with you. Break it up into sections.
- For preschool children, familiarize yourself with the story, and just tell the story to the children.
- Stop at certain intervals to ask questions about what you have just read or said.
- Explain what words mean, especially terms that are not common today.

## Discussion

- What did King Nebuchadnezzar want Shadrack, Meshack and Abednego to do?
- Shadrack, Meshack and Abednego showed courage and trusted God. How did they show the King that their trust was in God?
- Have you ever been in a situation that you had to choose to do the right thing even though it was not what everyone else was doing.
- When you trust God, you allow Him to work in your life. God will be with you when you are going through difficult times. During this pandemic, there are many people that are fearful. What can you do to help them to put their trust in God?
