<p><b>May 10</b></p> <p><b>Bible Verse</b> Memorize this week's bible verse: I will hasten and not delay to obey your commands. Psalm 119:60</p> <p>Make a poster out of the verse and post it where you will be reminded that God wants you to obey.</p>	<p><b>May 11</b></p> <p><b>Wall Hanger</b></p>  <p>Cut out a circle and 4-5 rectangles. On the circle, write "I Will". On each rectangle write what you can do to obey:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Follow directions right away</li> <li>-Follow directions completely</li> <li>-Follow directions with a happy heart</li> <li>-Learn what God wants of me</li> <li>-Add anything else that you want to add.</li> </ul> <p>Use yarn or string to connect the circle to the rectangles.</p>	<p><b>May 12</b></p> <p><b>Freeze Game</b> Have the family assemble in one place. Give a command that the group must do until you say freeze. Everyone must freeze in place. First one to move is out. Play until you have a winner. Younger kids would like this game without eliminating anyone.</p>	<p><b>May 13</b></p> <p><b>Happy Heart Chart</b> Cut out a large heart. Make small happy faces. Every time you obey with a happy heart, glue a happy face on the heart. This can remind you to act with a happy heart/</p>	<p><b>May 14</b></p> <p><b>Bean Bag Toss</b> Toss the bean bag and catch it without letting it fall on the ground. Challenge yourself by tossing it higher or try catching it behind your back. Continue and try new ways of catching the bean bag. If you don't have a bean bag you can make one from fabric and beans. Look up instruction online.</p>	<p><b>May 15</b></p> <p><b>Obey Your Lord</b> How many names can you make out of the words "Obey Your Lord". I made 15 words. See if you can top that.</p>	<p><b>May 16</b></p> <p><b>Butterfly Craft</b></p>  <p>With the weather changing, there are many insects that are showing up. Make one of my favorites, a butterfly by using an empty toilet paper roll for the body. Decorate it with markers or glue tissue paper on it. Make wings that are taller than the paper roll and decorate it using. Glue it together and add 2 antennas made from paper, pipe cleaners, twigs or anything you find at home.</p>
