

Obedience

Bible Passage: Jonah 1: 1-17, 2:1-2, 2:10, 3:1-10- 4:1-10

Memory Verse: I will hasten and not delay to obey your commands. Psalm 119:60

Read the passage to the children

- The passages are long so make sure that the kids can summarize sections of the story as they are reading with you. Break it up into sections.
- For preschool children, familiarize yourself with the story, and just tell the story to the children.
- Stop at certain intervals to ask questions about what you have just read or said.
- Explain what words mean, especially terms that are not common today.

Discussion

- Why do you think that Jonah did not want to go to Nineveh?
- God's forgiveness and love is for all people. God wants us to share that with others around us. What are ways that you have shared God's love with others?
- Can you think of someone that needs to hear that message of forgiveness and love? Who would that be and how will you get that message to them?
- Do you obey, right away, with a happy heart?
