

The Gospel Spreads

Bible Passage: Acts 9:1-22, 10:1-48

Memory Verse: For this is how God loved the world: He gave his uniquely existing Son so that everyone who believes in him would not be lost but have eternal life.

John 3:16

Read the passage to the children

- The passages are long so make sure that the kids can summarize sections of the story as they are reading with you. Break it up into sections.
- For preschool children, familiarize yourself with the story, and just tell the story to the children.
- Stop at certain intervals to ask questions about what you have just read or said.
- Explain what words mean, especially terms that are not common today.

Discussion

- The followers of Jesus wanted to spread the Good news that Jesus is Lord of all. Remember that Jesus told his disciples to go to all the world to share the good news. Can you think of someone who shares that good news?
- Peter had to learn that he had to find ways to share the good news with everyone. Think of ways that you can share the good news with others. Make a list of different ways that you can talk to others about Jesus. Try them out this week.
