

Respect

Bible Passage: Genesis 4:1-16

Memory Verse: The eyes of the LORD are in every place observing both the evil and the good.
Proverb 15:3

Read the passage to the children

- Ask the kids to summarize sections of the story as they are reading with you. Break it up into sections.
- For preschool children, familiarize yourself with the story, and just tell the story to the children.
- Stop at certain intervals to ask questions about what you have just read or said.
- Explain what words mean, especially terms that are not common today.

Discussion

- Compare and contrast the two brothers.
- Why was God pleased with Abel's sacrifice and not Cain's sacrifice?
- Cain did not show God respect because he did not do what was asked and expected of him. Think of times that you did not show God respect by not being respectful. How can you change that?
