

<p>July 26 Bible Verse Be Kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving on another, as God in Christ forgave you. Ephesians 4:32</p> <p>Memorize the bible verse. Practice by repeating it to your family members.</p>	<p>July 27 Bible Verse Puzzle Draw a rectangle on a piece of paper leaving about 1 inch on each side. Cut it out. Write out the bible verse using bubble letters and color it. On the back of the page that you just colored, draw 3 lines from the top to the bottom of the page. Your lines can be straight or curvy. Make sure that they are spaced as even as you can. Do the same from left to right. Now cut on the lines that you just drew. Using another piece of paper, arrange your piece and glue it on.</p> 	<p>July 28 I Can Forgive... Make a list of as many different things that you can forgive someone for. Example: When someone lies to me, when someone takes my toy without asking, etc. Use this list to practice what you would say to people when they do these things to you. Remember that Jesus said to forgive others 70 times 7.</p>	<p>July 29 I Will Forgive Necklace</p>  <p>Draw a circle on a piece of cardboard. Write the words I will forgive in the center of the circle. Color the whole circle. Cut out the circle and make a hole on the top. Thread in yarn or string long enough to use as a necklace. Keep this to remind yourself to be a forgiving person.</p>	<p>July 30 Letter Writing It is always good to share what you have learned. Using the what you learned about forgiveness and your list that you made on Tuesday, write a letter telling why it is important to forgive others. Add the story that Jesus told in his parable about forgiveness. Send the letter to someone that you love.</p>	<p>July 31 Count the Stars Sit outside or by a window after dark. Count the stars you can see. Look closer and you will see a lot more stars. Remember that in Jesus' parable you cannot count the times that you forgive others just like you cannot count the stars in the sky.</p>	<p>August 1 Toy Give Away Go through all your toys. Are there some that you no longer play with? Separate the toys that you no longer use into a box. Ask your parents to help you take them to the Lighthouse resale store or any other resale shop to give other kids in need a chance to play with that toy that you no longer play with. Remember that you would not like to be given a broken toy, so don't add any toys that are not longer usable.</p>
