

# Wonderfully Made

**Bible Passage:** Psalms 139:1-16

**Memory Verse:** I will give thanks *and* praise to You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made;  
Wonderful are Your works, and my soul knows it very well.

Psalms 139:14 (AMP)

## Read the passage to the children

- Ask the kids to summarize sections of the story as they are reading with you. Break it up into sections.
- For preschool children, familiarize yourself with the passage, and just tell the story to the children.
- Stop at certain intervals to ask questions about what you have just read or said.
- Explain what words mean, especially terms that are not common today.

## Discussion

- What does the Bible passage say that God knows about us?
- At what point in our lives did God know about us? What specific verse tells you this?
- What did God make in you that you think is special?
