<p><b>August 9</b>  <b>Bible Verse</b>            Then you will know the truth and the truth will set you free.            John 8:32</p> <p>Memorize the bible verse. Practice by repeating it to your family members.</p>	<p><b>August 10</b>  <b>School Prayer</b>            Discuss some things that worry you about school with your family. Make sentence prayers and ask God to help you with those things.</p>	<p><b>August 11</b>  <b>Mixed Up Verse</b>            Write the verse on a piece of paper and leave some extra space between the words. Cut out the words and rearrange the words in order. Glue them on a piece of paper.</p>	<p><b>August 12</b>  <b>Truth Design</b>            On a piece of paper write the word truth using as much of the space as possible. Tear up little pieces of colorful tissue paper and roll each piece into a tiny ball. Glue the tiny balls on the lines of the word truth. Once you are done you can place it on your wall.</p>	<p><b>August 13</b>  <b>Truth and False Game</b>            Make 2 signs, one with truth and the other with false. Each person will take turns telling a story that is either the truth or false. The players will raise the sign according to if they think the story is the truth or false.</p>	<p><b>August 14</b>  <b>Pencil Holder</b>            Get an empty soup can. Make sure that it is clean from food and dried. Wrap twine or yarn around the outside of the can until the whole can is covered. Use it to put your pencils and other school supplies.</p>	<p><b>August 15</b>  <b>Rainbow Name</b>            Write your name on the center of a piece of paper leaving spaces between each letter. Use markers or color pencils to trace around each letter using different colors. Continue until you are out of space.</p>
